# The Hard Rock Shed Photo Tips

We will shoot until we get the best photos possible!

#### Wardrobe:

Choose outfits that fit you well and express your personality.

#### Clothes:

Clothes should compliment, not compete. Simple is best. Avoid patterns, stripes, dots, checks, paisley, floral prints, Hawaiian shirts, or logos. Select fabrics that move well and drape gracefully rather than stiff fabrics like linens. Make sure your clothes are in good condition because the camera can see everything.

#### Colors:

Colors are important. Light pastels like pale yellow will photograph white. Dark colors like navy will photograph black. Wear black for theatrical shots as it has a more dramatic look. Contrast clothing to your hair color.

#### **Accessories:**

Try to avoid high gloss lip products.

### Relax:

Be sure to get plenty of rest the night before. Allow enough time to get to your photo shoot so you are not rushed or late! It is important for you to be calm, positive, and comfortable.
